Privacy Policy

We recognize that the privacy of your personal information is important. The purpose of this policy is to let you know how we handle the information collected through the use of this website. This policy does not apply to information collected through other means, such as by telephone or in person, although that information is protected by other privacy policies.

We are required by law to maintain the privacy of your personal health information (“PHI”); provide you with notice of our legal duties and privacy practices with respect to PHI; and notify you if your PHI is affected in a breach of unsecured PHI.

This website is intended for a United States audience. Any information you provide, including any personal information, will be transferred to and processed by a computer server located within the United States.

How We Protect Your Privacy

Our staff is trained on the need to maintain your PHI in the strictest confidence. We restrict access to your PHI to authorized staff who needs information for your treatment, for payment purposes and/or for health care operations. We maintain technical, physical and administrative safeguards to ensure the privacy of your PHI. In addition, in situations where we rely on a third party to perform business, professional or insurance services or functions for us, that third party must agree to safeguard your PHI. That Business Associate must also agree to use it only as required to perform its functions for us and as otherwise permitted by our contract and the law.

HIPAA Security Information

In accordance with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (“HIPAA”) and applicable state medical privacy laws, we are committed to maintaining the privacy and security of your health information.

We take our security measures very seriously and commit to doing everything possible to ensure that your data and electronic communication is secure and HIPAA compliant.

Below are just some of the security measures we have in place:

- We use a high level of encryption when communicating to our servers.
- We have strict security policies and access control measures to prevent access to PHI.
- Our practice management software is designed to ensure HIPAA compliance.
- All third party vendors contracted with our practice have agreed to safeguard your PHI.
